

### PAeC PARTICIPATION AT DUBAI AIRSHOW 2025 FEATURES SUPER MUSHSHAK MR SIMULATOR



The Pakistan Aerospace Council (PAeC) demonstrated remarkable participation and international engagement at the Dubai Airshow 2025, with multiple PAeC member companies presenting cutting-edge innovations and advanced aerospace capabilities at the PAeC pavilion.

A major highlight was the Super Mushshak Mixed-Reality (MR) Simulator, allowing visitors and industry professionals to experience immersive flight simulation. Developed jointly by Aviation MRO Pvt Limited and FSDC AeroSolutions, the system offered zero-risk, zero-fuel pilot training and precision-driven skill development, reflecting Pakistan's growing engineering and training expertise.

In addition to the simulator, RWR Pvt

Limited engaged attendees on the evolving role of Electronic Warfare (EW) in modern operations, while SoluNox Pvt Limited showcased its advanced embedded electronics and avionics solutions, and Paradigm 3D presented its certified aerospace additive manufacturing capabilities, including high-performance components for aircraft interiors and defense applications.

The pavilion attracted delegates from Turkey, Azerbaijan, Oman, Europe, and across the Gulf region, providing PAeC members a platform to connect with global aerospace leaders, highlight indigenous innovation, and explore collaboration opportunities. The event underscored Pakistan's growing presence in the global aerospace and defence ecosystem.
